Why an I.B. Education?

There is no better preparation for college success.

You are about to go to High School - time to choose a school, classes and programs. We are one of 4200 schools around the world that must meet rigorous international criteria.

You will learn time-management and study skills including learning to become a better writer and public speaker. You will likely have higher SAT scores. You can earn college credits for some of your courses (all Colorado state schools grant 24 hours of credit to students who earn an IB diploma).

College scholarships can be much greater- colleges like IB graduates. In the spring of 2021, our IB graduates received \$4.8 million in scholarships from various colleges.
