DCHS School Accountability Committee (SAC)

What is the SAC?

The SAC is a state mandated committee of parents, teachers, administrators and a community member that meet monthly to review the status of the school budget and the school improvement plans. Safety issues are also discussed and the committee is responsible for providing input to the District Accountability Committee regarding principal evaluation forms and any other issues that might be of concern.
